



Community Action of Minneapolis (CAMPLS) Family Stabilization Program

SUMMARY:

The Family Stabilization Program (FSP) provides **one-time, short-term* financial assistance** to Minneapolis residents who have fallen behind on basic living needs due to crisis when no other funds are available to resolve the crisis. In order to facilitate stability, FSP may assist with basic needs such as food, car repair, water bills, and rent assistance. **Assistance may only be requested once.**

GUIDELINES:

In accordance with CAMPLS guidelines, applicants for FSP must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Must be a Minneapolis resident for at least 90 days with a valid MN photo ID.
2. Must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Must meet income guidelines based on federal poverty guidelines- 200%.
All income must be verified for the past 90 days for all household members.
4. Must have accessed Hennepin County Emergency Assistance twice in the past year (if you have children).
5. Must have applied (or apply at appt.) for Energy Assistance for 2009-2010.
6. Documented proof of required assistance (I.e. shut-off notice, eviction notice, etc). Failure to provide all required documentation will result in a denial.
