



## Community Action of Minneapolis (CAMPLS) Children and Family Development: Family Stabilization Program

**Summary:** The Family Stabilization Program (FSP) will provide **one-time, short-term\*** financial assistance to Minneapolis residents in crisis that has caused the individual or family to fall behind on basic living needs when no other funds are available to resolve the crisis. In order to assist families with maintaining their stability, FSP may assist with basic needs such as food, medicine, transportation, childcare, and rent/mortgage. **Assistance may only be requested once.**

**Guidelines:** In accordance with CAMPLS guidelines, each applicant for FSP must meet the following to be eligible for service:

1. Must be a Minneapolis resident for at least 90 days with a valid photo ID.
2. Must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Must meet income guidelines based on federal policy guidelines- 200%. Income must be verified for the past 90 days for all household members.
4. Must have accessed Emergency Assistance through Hennepin County within the past year (Sept 08-Sept 09).
5. Must have applied for Energy Assistance for 2009-2010 (or apply).
6. Documented proof of required assistance (i.e. shut-off notice, eviction notice, loss of job, etc).
